Dear Friends,

It is with great pleasure and heartfelt thanks that I send this letter to you, reporting that the Ecuador Radio Project will be brought to completion in a few months. Your generous gift and faithful prayers have enabled MAF to install 83 high frequency and VHF radios in Ecuador, allowing us to more effectively share the love of God with isolated people.

As you may recall, this project was to be carried out in three phases. Phase one concluded in May 2004 with the installation of the north and south repeaters. The first step of phase two required an evaluation of the village equipment, and an order for 60 radios was placed in March, 2005. The equipment was received in customs in August 2005, but clearance wasn't given nor phase two finalized until January 2006.

Phase three of the project included ordering the last 23 radios and commencing with the installation process. Installations began in February 2006.

Nearly all of the targeted villages are now connected to the outside world, thanks to your partnership with MAF. Ten of the installed radios will be relocated during the next few months, bringing an end to the entire project.

As a token of our gratitude for your generosity, please accept the enclosed video showing part of the radio installation process. The eternal impact of the simple presence of these radios will be immeasurable.

Please pray for MAF as we continue to serve on your behalf in Ecuador. Many isolated people have already benefited and will continue to receive our assistance in this very remote region.
